We had a very successful disco for our tamariki last Friday at school. We would like to thank OFOTS for their mahi in planning and organising an awesome disco!



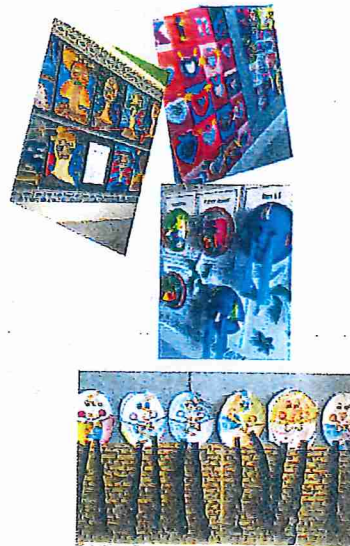
Ōwhata Sports:

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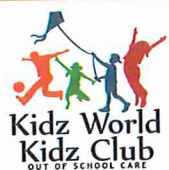
